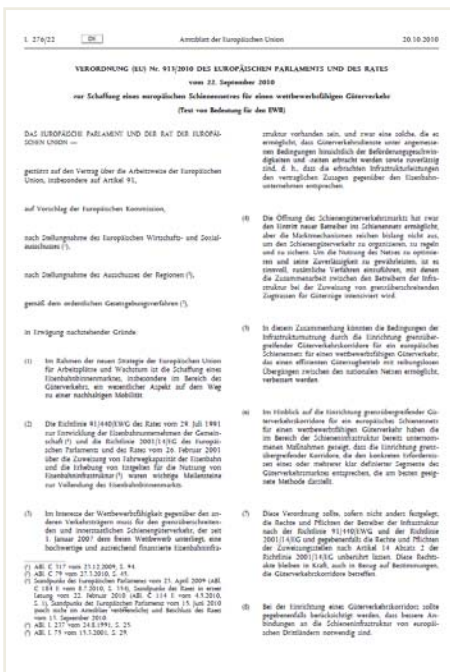

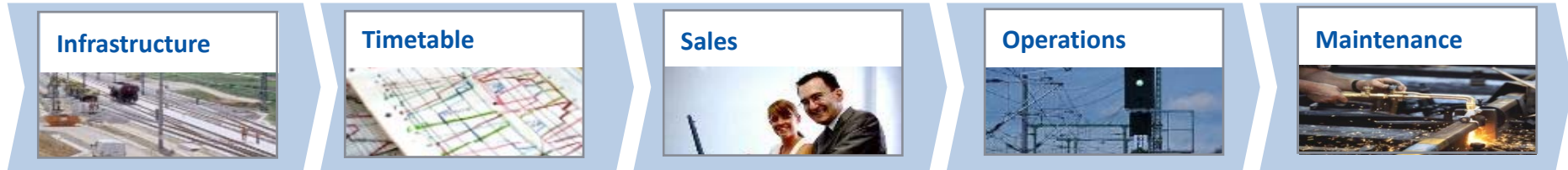

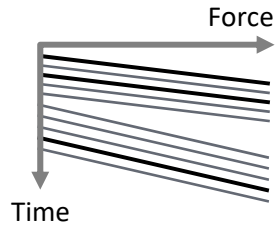
Core elements (EU) 913/2010
